Mission. To put on a fun, well thought out, safe and balanced multi-gun match that all levels of shooters can enjoy.

Safety. The safety of our shooters, staff and spectators is of the utmost importance. Any unsafe act will result in a Match DQ.

When not shooting a stage, pistols should be unloaded and holstered at all times, rifles and shotguns shall be either muzzle up or down with the action open if an appropriate safety flag is not used. Safe areas will be clearly marked, no ammunition shall be handled at the safe areas.

Rules;

#1 SCORING:

Scoring will be the IDPA scoring system, Points Down

#2 GEAR

Holsters: Any holster that **SECURELY** holds the firearm. Holsters must be worn on the waist or leg (thigh).

Holsters that are not allowed:

Cross Draw Holsters
Shoulder Holsters
Small of the back Holsters

Handgun Mag Pouches: Any pouch that securely holds a Mag or speed loader/moon clip is allowed. Pouches may be worn on any part of the body.

Rifle Mag Pouches: Any type. Pouches may be worn on any part of the body or gun.

Shotshell Holders: Any type. Holders may be worn on any part of the body or gun.

Clothing: Any type of clothing and or tactical gear is permitted . Rude or inappropriate Sayings or pictures are not permitted.

Footwear: Any good footwear, but NO CLEATS

Protective wear: The wearing of knee pads/elbow pads is allowed.
Eye and ear protection is mandatory.

3 **Firearms** / Magazines / Speed loaders

Pistols: Auto / Revolver Minimum cal. 9mm, pistol calibers only.

Rifles: Any semi-auto center fire rifle including Pistol Cal. Carbines
FMJ, SP or HP only

*****Use of Armor Piercing or steel core Ammo will be A Match DQ*****

Rifle Calibers Allowed:

Minor Rifle Cal. (5.56X45 / 5.56X39 / 5.45X39 / 7.62X39 / 30 Carbine)

Major Rifle Cal. (308 Win / 30.06 / 8mm / 7.62 X 54 / 6.8 SPC)

Pistol Cal. Carbine: 9mm Min. 45 ACP Max.

Shotgun: Auto or Pump 20 Gauge Min. / 12 Gauge Max.

Magazines: Pistol - Max Length [See division rules] Capacity Limit:[See division rules]
Rifle - Max Length None Capacity Limit: Per Division Rules Shotgun – Per
Division Rules [see section # 4]

Speed Loaders: Revolvers- Any

Rifle – Use of a “Beta Mag” or other drum type of ammunition feeding system will put you in open class.

Shotgun- Magazine or drum style shotshell feeding systems will put you in open class. Division Rules [see section #4]

#4 **Divisions:** Open / Tactical / Limited / Iron Man

Shooters will be able to compete in one of (4) different Divisions.

TACTICAL: In Tactical Division you are allowed (1) Optical / Electronic Sight on the Firearm of **YOUR** choice:

including grip, sights, recoil...etc.

Limited Division: In The Limited Division All (3) Firearms must only have Iron Sights but are also allowed the following modifications:

LIMITED SHOTGUN:

LIMITED PISTOL:

Modifications Allowed:

Trigger work

Magazines- Double Stack -140mm max length/Single Stack-170mm

Any pistol/revolver that would be allowed in:

A: USPS- limited/limited10, production, single stack or revolver

B: IDPA- SSP, ESP, CDP, SSR or ESR Gun

Modifications including grip, sights, recoil...etc.

IRON MAN: This Division requires the shooter to use a 45 CAL. Pistol.

With a magazine restriction of only **(8) ROUNDS.**

A 12 Ga. Pump Shotgun with only iron sites.

The Rifle must be a Major Caliber and is restricted to **20 rounds** in the mag.

Ammunition Capacity-9 rounds (8) in the Mag (1) in the chamber

IRON MAN PISTOL: 45 Calibers Only

Modifications Allowed:

Iron Sights Only

Trigger work

Magazines- 8 Rounds Max

Any .45 caliber or larger pistol caliber semi auto or revolver.

Gun Modifications: grips, sights, recoil....etc.
